REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATE AND EXPLANATION OF MAJOR FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS

Clarity Singapore Limited has a surplus of \$216,688 for the year ended 30 September 2015. Total income and expenses were \$778,353 and \$561,665 respectively.

Significant and new income items were donations of \$80,100 from fundraising dinner drive which commenced in June 2015 and dinner held on 5 November 2015, and Care & Share Matching Grant of \$137,794 received in the financial year.

Staff cost remained the largest expense item due to the service nature of our charitable activities. Our reserves is \$796,088 as at 30 September 2015, held by time deposits of \$500,000.

REVIEW AND CHANGES IN MEMORANDUM AND ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

Clause 6 and 9 of the Memorandum of Association and Articles 4, 6, 7 17, 20, 32, 32A, 38A, 45 and 47 of the Articles of Association has been amended with approval from Commissioner of Charities, Ministry of Social and Family.

This has been approved by members at the Extraordinary General Meeting held on 23 February 2016.

The charity's assets mainly comprise computer, office equipment and furniture. They are used to enable staff to carry out the charitable activities of Clarity Singapore Limited.
