

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATE AND EXPLANATION OF MAJOR FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS

Significant and new income items were one-off donations of:-

- 1. \$185,800 from a fundraising anniversary dinner drive which commenced in June 2015, and dinner held on 5 November 2015
- 2. \$85,000 from Singapore Island Country Club
- 3. \$607,463 from Care & Share Matching Grant (which ended on 31 March 2016)

The above resulted to a surplus of \$637,401 for the year ended 30 September 2016, which will be used for planned programmes in 2017

Total income and expenses were \$1,374,690 and \$737,289 respectively. Our reserves was \$1,433,489 as at 30 September 2016 Fixed Deposits is \$1,070,000 to-date
